JEWEL OF KATHIAWAR - JAMNAGAR

Jamnagar is a city in the western Indian state of Gujarat, located on the coast of the Gulf of Kutch. It is known for its rich history, beautiful temples, and industrial significance. Here are some key points about Jamnagar:


